Do you think this is a positive or negative development?

Introduction - make a general comment about the topic based on your general knowledge & experience and/or the current situation in your country. Make it clear to the reader if you think it's a positive or negative development.

Para 1a (if you think positive) – focus on advantages of going to university

- greater job prospects in the future
- possibility to start career at higher level / earn better salary
- possible opportunities to work overseas

Para 1b (if you think negative) – focus on drawbacks of going to university

- students get into a lot of debt
- if unemployment high, no guarantee of job
- overqualified for many jobs that are available
- no work experience

iPass tip – even if you think it's a positive development, include at least one negative aspect to show you have considered the alternative viewpoint.

Para 2a – focus on advantages for society of having more qualified workforce

- more highly skilled workers
- more competitive in world market
- boosts productivity / innovation / national economy

Para 2b – focus on drawbacks of people starting work later in life

- fewer people paying taxes / contributing to economy
- not enough people doing manual jobs / learning practical skills
- people having (fewer) children later in life (possible health risks)

Conclusion – reaffirm your own opinion by summing up your main idea/argument but avoid using the same vocabulary.

iPass tip – leave the reader with an interesting thought or question to consider regarding how the situation might develop in the future.
